

**Resolution 538/XI of the Parliament of Catalonia, concerning forced sterilisations in Peru**

In the session held on March 16, 2017, the Committee on Foreign Affairs and Cooperation, Institutional Relations and Transparency discussed the text of the draft resolution concerning forced sterilisations in Peru (procedure 250-00601/11), as presented by the Socialist Parliamentary Group, and the amendments tabled by the Junts Pel Sí Parliamentary Group (Together for Yes) (reg. 42738).

Lastly, in accordance with Rule 165 of the Rules of Procedure, the Parliament has adopted the following

**RESOLUTION**

1. The Parliament of Catalonia expresses its solidarity with all those who were victims of forced sterilisation policies in Peru between 1995 and 2000, and deplores and rejects the classist, racist and sexist nature of this policy.
2. The Parliament of Catalonia urges the Catalan Government to demand that the Government of Spain and the international community call on the Government of Peru for an impartial investigation and that sufficient resources are provided regarding the serious crimes that various members of the governments of Peru between 1995 and 2000 are accused of committing, in order to establish the truth regarding the events that occurred during this period.
3. The Parliament of Catalonia urges the Catalan Government to call on the Government of Spain and the international community to demand that the Government of Peru establishes an appropriate mechanism for the recognition and identification of victims who suffered the vile practices of forced sterilisation, provides justice to the victims, offers individual and collective reparations, provides the necessary health and psychological care required and that adequate guarantees are offered so that these practices never happen again.
4. The Parliament of Catalonia urges the Catalan Government to provide, through the Catalan cooperation policy, all necessary assistance to the organisations for Peruvian women and victims of forced sterilisation, so that they can pursue and achieve the objectives outlined in the Sections 2 and 3.
